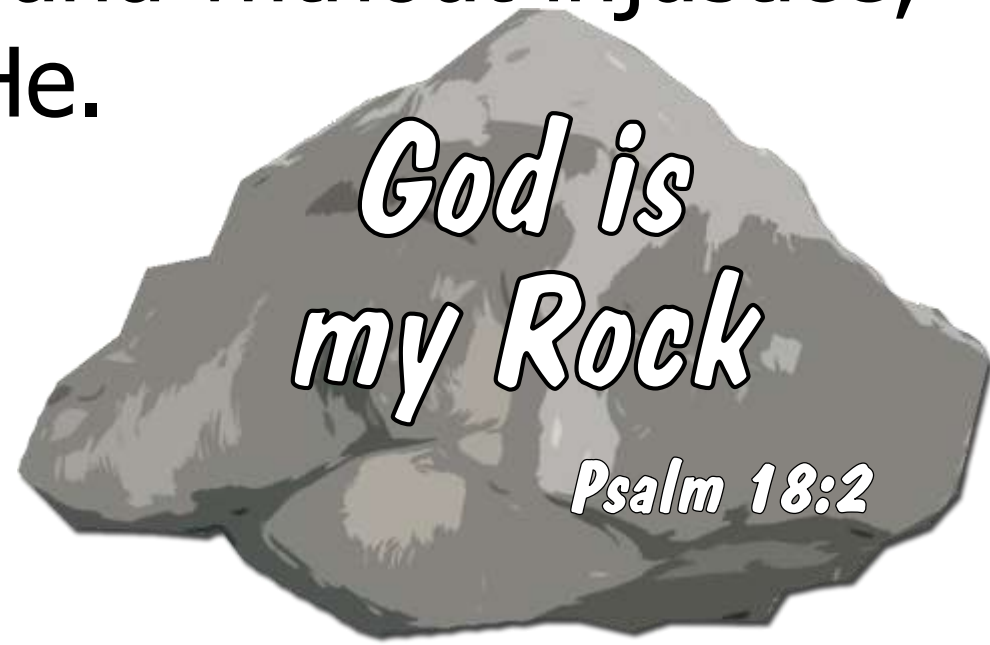

forgive my iniquity, though it is great.



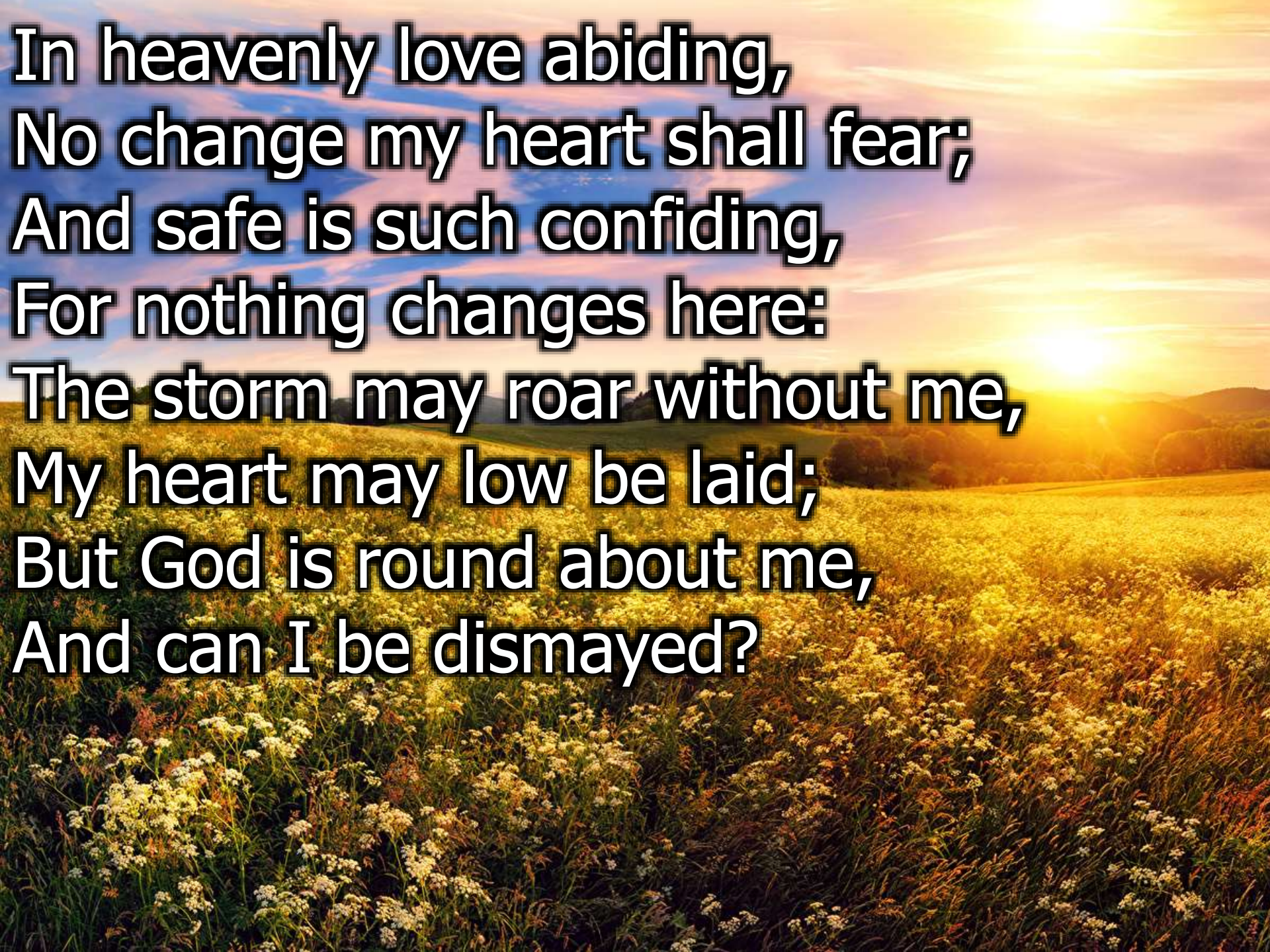

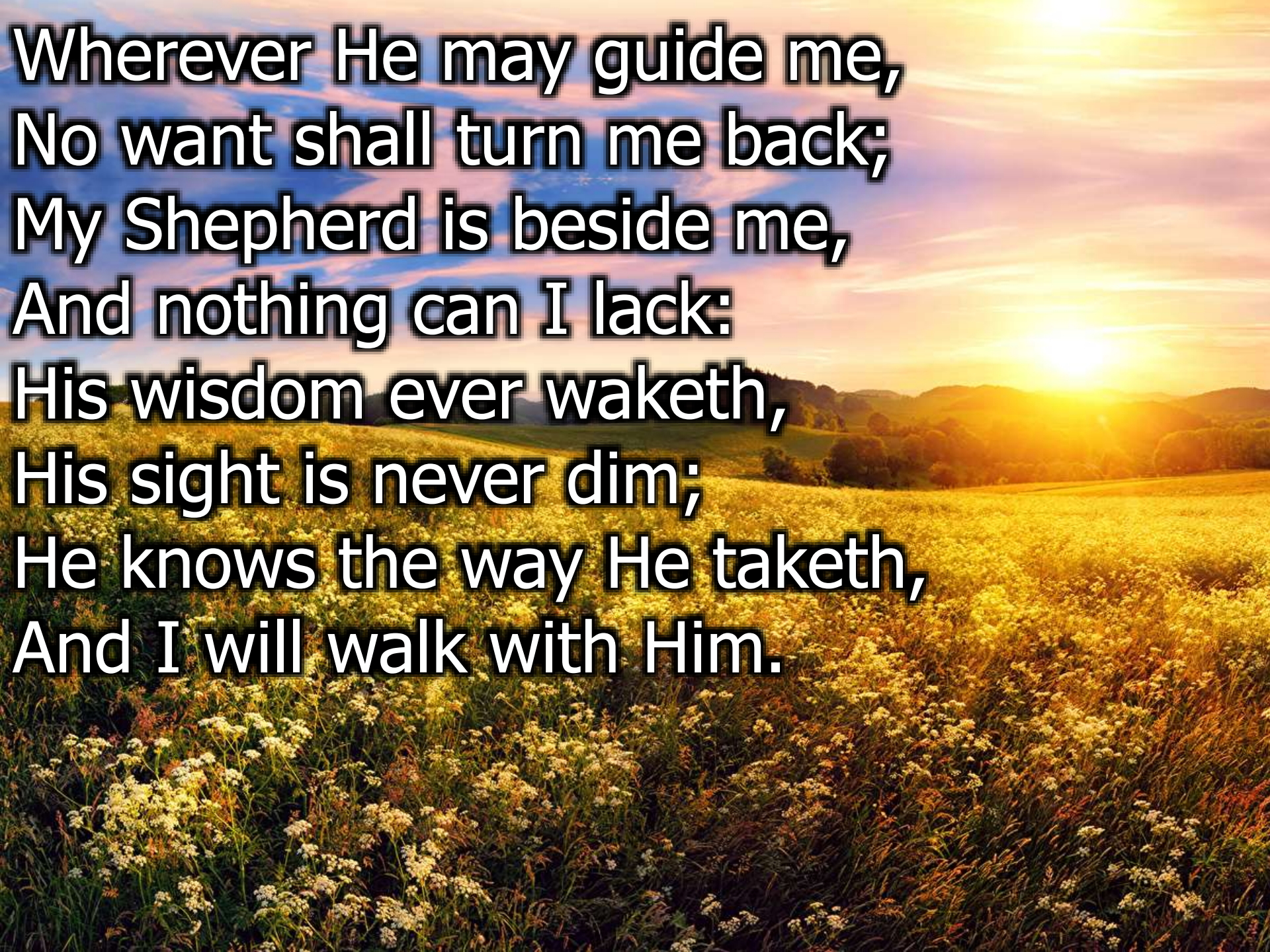
- ¹⁴ Righteousness and justice are the

our king to the Holy One of Israel.

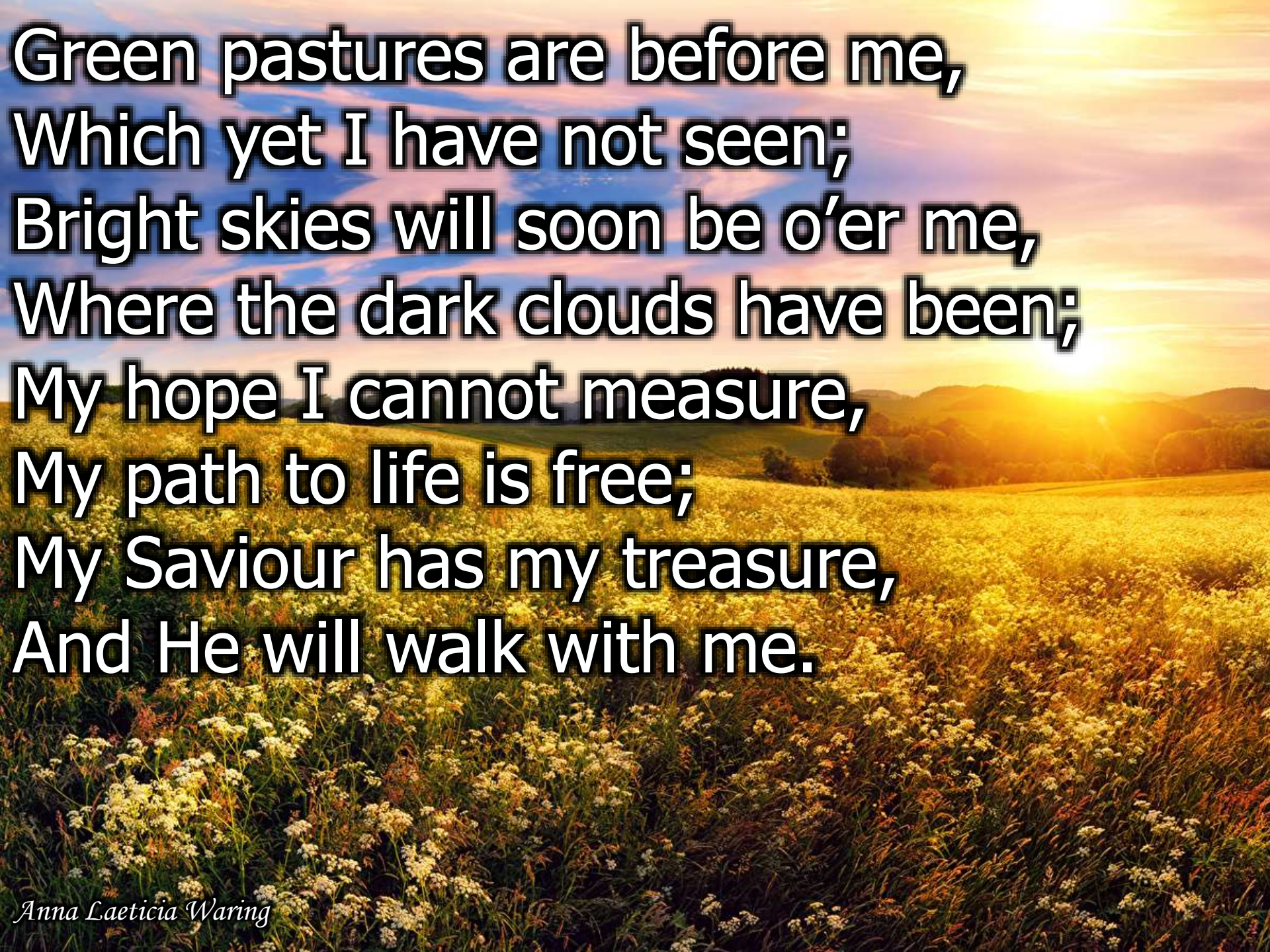

them.

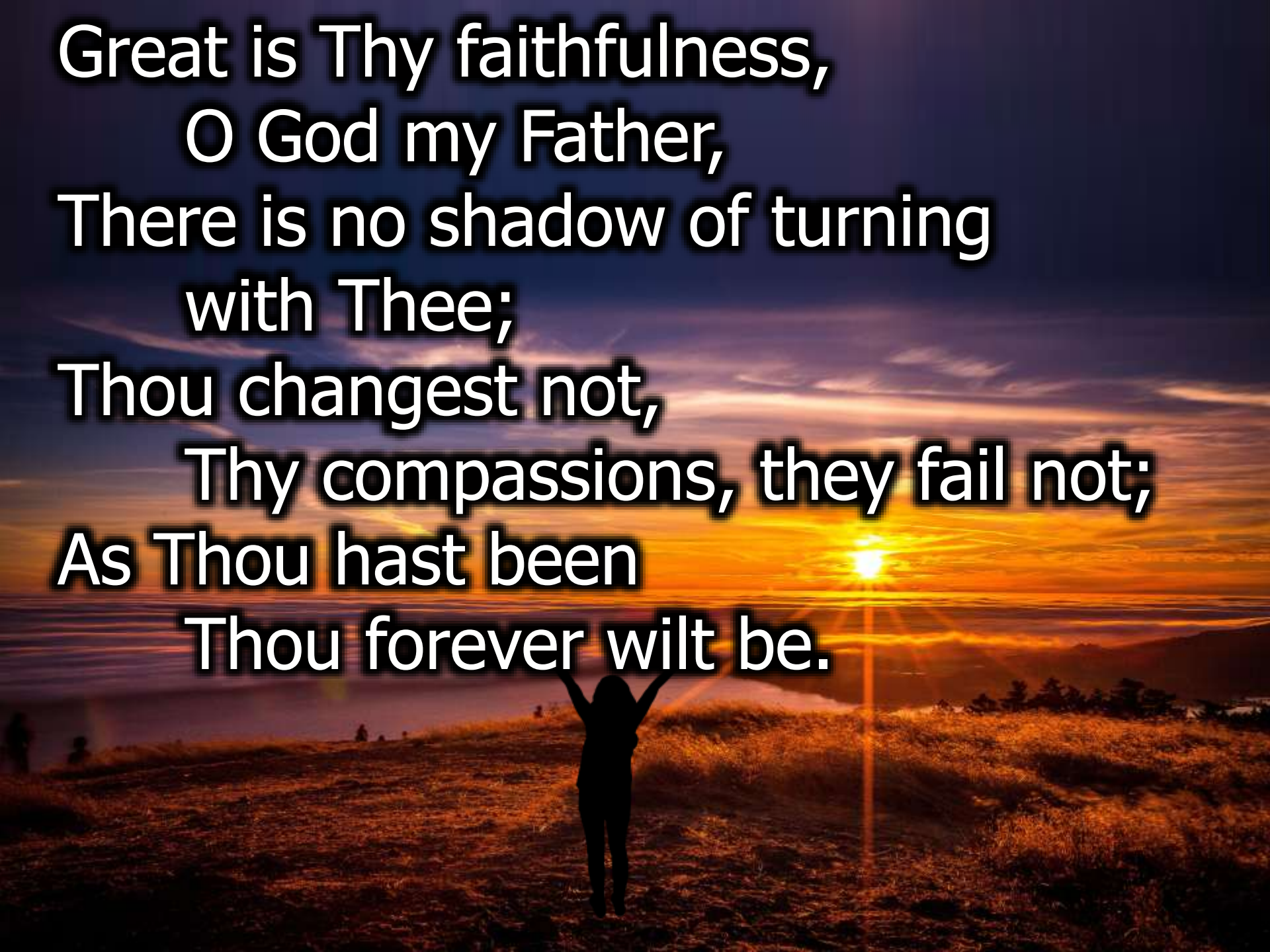
⁹ Their descendants will be known among

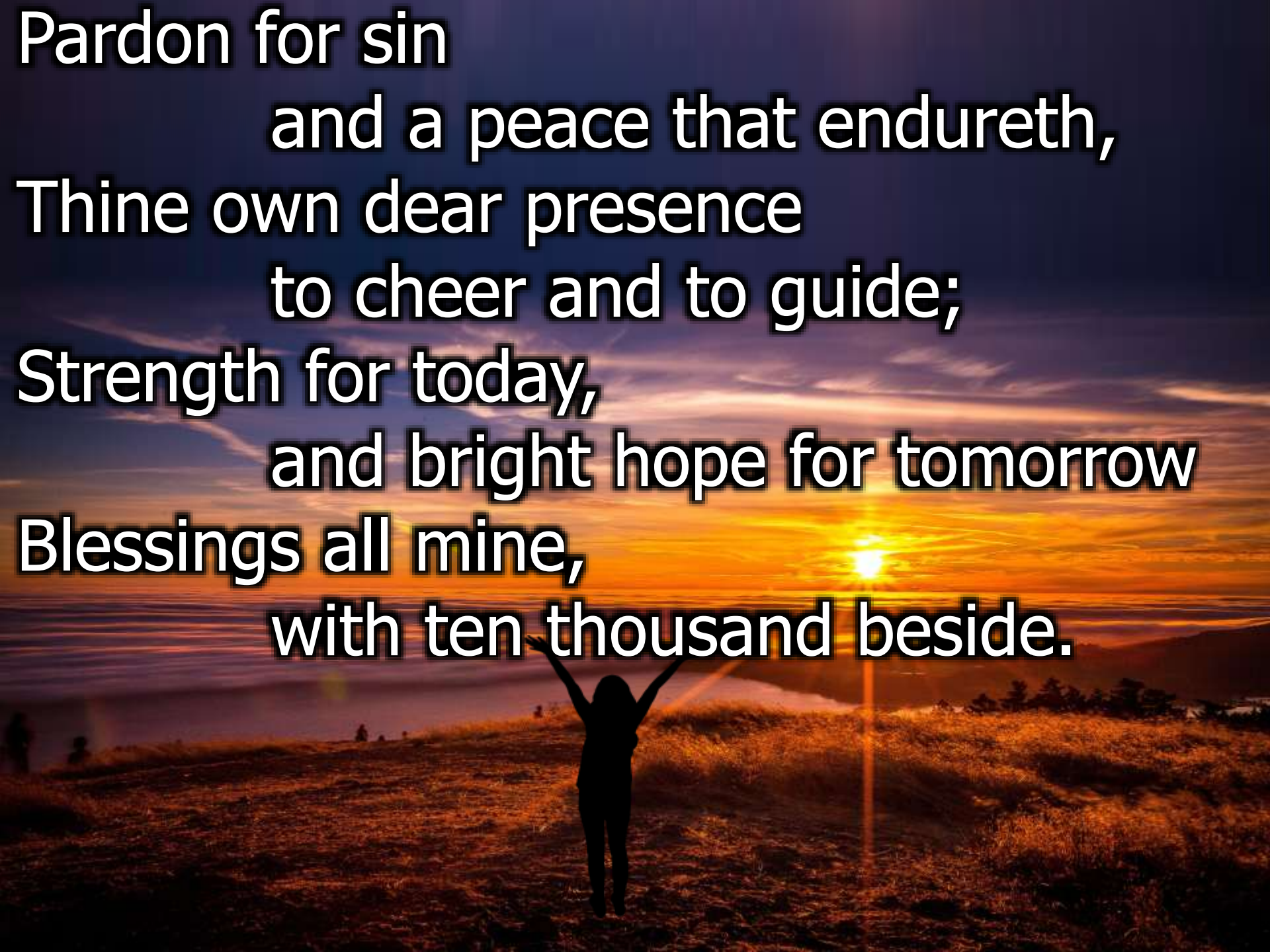
I have no merit to woo or delight Thee,
